

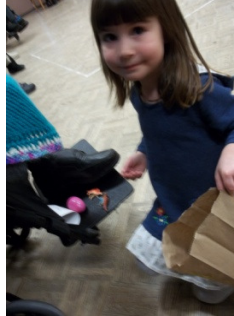

from the Toddler room:

The Toddlers are working on self-help skills by learning to serve themselves at lunch. It is a great experience for them and they may show you how well they are doing by wanting to serve themselves at home 😊. They are also working on feelings, how they feel as well as how others feel. Another skill they are developing is autonomy (setting goals and achieving them, rejecting the intrusion of redirection, seeking to control others, saying “Mine”, making choices and avoiding distractions.)

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News from the Preschool room!

In the Preschool room, the skills being developed are social skills, such as making friends, communication skills and language skills. The Preschoolers are also enhancing their gross motor and cognition skills. The Preschoolers are learning to ask "why" questions to determine cause. They are exploring this use through experimentation.

The children have been interested in many things and these interests are brought into planned activities by the Educators. The activities are planned around what skills the children need to be developing. Often, an interest may continue for days, weeks, or longer.
